In the identified area, the current year population is 55,532,826. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 55,233,164. The rate of change since 2020 was 0.17% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 55,631,694 representing a change of 0.04% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 49.3% male and 50.7% female.

## **Median Age**

The median age in this area is 40.4, compared to U.S. median age of 39.1.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 53.0 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 22,653,007, a change of 0.25% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.42, compared to 2.44 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 14,146,496 in the specified area.

Currently, 62.5% of the 24,629,225 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 28.4%, renter occupied; and 9.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 24,297,748 housing units in the area and 9.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.42%. Median home value in the area is \$223,839, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.60% annually to \$267,139.
